HELP WITH US!

In 2018, we managed not only to help our children by fulfilling the goals and objectives set by the Charity Program, but also to optimize the internal processes in the work of the fund:

We transferred accounting to outsourcing. For a long time we searched and looked closely in search of a team of specialists who really know the specifics of the work of NGOs and can provide us with reliable and competent support. And we did it. With the transfer of accounting to outsourcing, the fund's expenses for accounting support of programs and projects were halved, and instead of one accountant, we had a whole team of assistants. We have optimized and reduced the cost of technical support for the site.

We also transferred the management of programs and projects to the Planfix CRM system. This made it possible to more effectively monitor current processes, their execution, and now not a single task will be missed.

Also, much attention was paid to the processing of personal data. This is especially important, because before we help, we request the documents of the petitioners, check them for good faith, and previously we stored all the documents to confirm the eligibility of spending donors. However, with changes in the law, we have made every effort to clearly comply with the requirements of the law regarding personal data.

The event of the year was the charity DREAMS Show, thanks to which we first gathered together with children and benefactors of more than 1000 people. This gave very powerful support and showed how important it is to be together, doing good deeds!

A special breakthrough was the sharp increase in the number of teams and pilot projects in orphanages and centers for the promotion of family education, working according to the "Portage" methodology. And we are confidently moving in this direction so that once orphanages turn into centers of support for families raising children with severe and multiple developmental disabilities.

I am pleased to present the results of the work of dozens of people, as well as the results of the use of charitable donations in this report.

Take A Step has paid for treatments & rehabilitation for **301** children.



STRUCTURE OF FOUNDATION



The "Diema's Dream" Foundation is a Russian fund to help orphans and disabled children and is guided in its activity by Russian legislation on charity and non-profit organizations.

The supreme management is the Board of the Fund, which takes decisions on key issues of the organization's activities. The Supervisory Board and the Audit Commission control the work, use of the Fund's assets.

We regularly undergo an audit at the request of the donors, we provide an individual report on the expenditure of donations.

In accordance with the Charter of the Fund, the executive body is the Director. She manages the ongoing activities and implementation of charitable programs, which would be impossible without the participation of 26 specialists.

For each program we attract highly qualified specialists - managers, methodologists, defectologists, speech therapists, psychologists and lawyers. Volunteers and partner organizations are helping tremendously.

Annually, the specialists of the Foundation and the "Dimina Mechta" Center pass courses of professional development, participate in thematic conferences, increasing their professionalism.

Since 2014, the Fund has been guided by the Regulations for the Monitoring and Evaluation of Programs and Projects, developed by "Process Consult" Company. This allows us to monitor, analyze and improve the quality of our work.

Morgan Lewis provides legal services pro bono, which allows us not only to conduct our activities at a very high level, but also to save money by directing funds to help children.

Project "Canis-therapy"

THE GOAL – of the project is to rehabilitate and improve the quality of life of orphans with severe disabilities of psychophysical development through conducting Canis therapy.

THE BENEFICIARIES

- Children of the SSCV "Vera.Nadezhda.Lyubov", Moscow.
- Children of the SSCV "Trust" Moscow.


RESULTS: Over the course of the year, more than 100 children with severe and multiple developmental disabilities took part in canis-therapy sessions. 57 visits by canis therapists conducted 171 hours of sessions.

As a result practically everyone has positive changes:

- Children began to feel their body better
- Decreases of muscle spasm
- Improves coordination of movements
- Improves the emotional state
- Speech and other communication skills improve
- Phobias were gone
- Cognitive activity develops
- These children have become more independent



Verticalization Project



GOAL OF THE PROJECT is the rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of children and orphans of the "Mercy" group (with severe disorders of psychophysical development) through the organization of regular work of orthopedists and physiotherapy exercises to ensure that the child reaches the vertical position of the body.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- We pay for work and travel of orthopedists from the federal orthopedic center in Moscow to children over 350 km from Moscow
- We pay for the daily work of specialists of adaptive physical education, massage, dressing of orthoses
- We pay the costs of hospitalization of orphans from the Ryazan region to a hospital in Moscow: we provide nannies, hygiene products and food

PROJECT PARTICIPANTS:

- 16 Children from Elatma`s orphanage
- 22 Children from Pervomaysky orphanage
- 21 Children from Doveriye orphanage

THANKS TO THE PROJECT many children:

- learned to stand by themselves, some walk completely independently, someone with support by hands or with walkers,
- to varying degrees, in all children the muscles of the neck, back, legs strengthened, everyone continues to grow and gain weight,
- the children are increasingly showing interest in the world around them, have become attentive, active, sociable and smiling

PROJECT RESULTS

- 3 visits by an orthopedic professor to regional orphanages (350 km. From Moscow)
- A routine inspection of 16 orphans
- 43 medical reports were prepared to amend the Individual Rehabilitation and Subsequent Rehabilitation Programs
- Organized 2 hospitalizations of 8 children for orthopedic treatment.
- Paid the work of 2 specialists in the daily support of 16 children undergoing orthopedic treatment during the year.

ONE CHILD'S STORY VERTICALIZATION PROJECT









PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT – improving the quality of life of children in orphanages and boarding schools by organizing social, developmental, cultural, educational events and increasing material support, satisfying spiritual and material needs.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- We carry out developmental activities
- Organize rehabilitation and medical care
- We purchase wheelchairs, orthoses, other technical rehabilitation means
- Promote social adaptation of children
- Organize holidays, cultural, cognitive, volunteer activities
- Improve the living conditions of children (furniture, hygiene products, linens, clothes, shoes, etc.)
- We acquire special development equipment, materials for classes, development and creativity, methodological materials, equipment for playgrounds, sensory rooms, etc.
- We support the exchange of best practices in the field of rehabilitation and psychological care for children with special needs

In 2018, furniture and computers were transferred to 4 orphanages:

- Pervomaisky orphanage (Kostroma region),
- Arzamassky orphanage (Nizhny Novgorod region),
- Kimovsky orphanage (Tula region)
- and Elatomsky orphanage (Ryazan region).

All transportation costs are paid by the fund.









For wards from the Psychoneurological boarding school, fund volunteers held an origami master class, and gatherings, communication and tea drinking are our favorite pastimes together.





Thanks to IKEA, we provided graduates of the Kimovsky Orphanage with everything necessary for independent living: a set of dishes, bedding, even ironing boards, as well as detergents and equipment from Amway, were given to the children with best wishes.





NEW YEAR'S HOLIDAYS: together with company employees, we collected individual and group Christmas gifts for children from orphanages.

OFFICE GOODS, BOOKS, DEVELOPING TOYS AND GAMES, PRODUCTS FOR CREATIVITY: we collected all this for a year and passed it to the wards.

INDIVIDUAL MATERIAL HELP: Wards of the Psychoneurological boarding school purchased clothes, shoes, warm winter clothes (a down jacket, hat, scarf, socks, pajamas, etc.), a tablet, books, coloring books, a memory card, a protective case and glass on the phone.

EXCURSIONS, HIKES: assistance was provided to wards of the Psychoneurological boarding school No. 11 and a tourist trip to the Crimea was organized. The guys went with their escorts on a multi-day hike. Such events are very important for the overall development and social adaptation of children living in orphanages and boarding schools.

A trip to Moscow was organized for the DREAMS Show at the Russian Song Theater and meals on the day of the event for children from the Kimovsky Orphanage, participation of wards of PNI No. 11 in Moscow.



Portage Practice Project



OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT - Rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of orphans with severe disabilities of the psycho-physical development of the "Mercy" groups by conducting educational activities with children using the "Portage" method.

BENEFIT RECIPIENTS:

- Elatma Orphanage (Ryazan region)
- Doveriye Orphanage, Moscow
- Skolkovo Orphanage, Moscow
- Rybnov Orphanage(Ryazan Region)

As a result of this many years of painstaking work, children who were considered hopeless have acquired new skills that were previously inaccessible to them:

- wash and dress.
- chew and swallow food, feed yourself,
- sit and stand,
- distinguish colors, count, collect constructors, cut,
- and many other skills in the field of movement, cognition, self-service, socialization.

RESULTS: with 27 children with severe and multiple developmental disorders during the year, "mothers-nannies" were engaged in the Portage method and conducted 4,678 lessons per year.

Consultation of specialists of trust institutions with foreign colleagues on the application of the method "Portage and postural control.

Portage Practice Project

From 2013 to 2018:

- 19,367 individual sessions for children with severe intellectual and physical disabilities verticalization and development of life skills
- more than 5 years of work
- over 200 children
- 10 teams of Portage specialists
- 8 orphanages / CSSV in Moscow, Pskov, Arzamas, Ryazan and Kostroma regions



Portage Practice Project

How does the "Portage" method work?

Natasha K: At the beginning of the Portage class, she showed no interest, was passive, there was no contact with a specialist. During the project, she began to interact with the teacher and show interest, it became easier for her to move, take toys, the child smiles more and more.

The greatest success in Natasha's classes - the girl learned to eat with a spoon and imitate adults. For 6 months, Natasha acquired 8 skills: 2 - from the sphere of Socialization (imitation of playing hide and seek, clapping, imitation of adults), 2 - from the sphere of Cognition (taking objects out of the box, putting an object into a box), 2 - Movement skills (work with a scoop, holds a spoon or scoop, imitates the actions of a teacher, rolls the ball), 2 - skills in the direction of Self-service (removes and puts a hat on his head, eats liquid food).



Portage Practice Project

How does the "Portage" method work?

As a result of classes, children began to develop and acquire skills in the field of movement, cognition, communication and self-service. They learned to do many things that were not available to them before:

Wash, wash hands and dress, chew and swallow food, drink and eat on your own,

sit, stand, walk with support or alone, distinguish colors,

count, collect simple sets, cut with scissors, play and much more.



Portage Pilot Teams Project



OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT – Rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of orphans with severe diseases. Dissemination of the best practices of working with children of the "Mercy" group and children with severe and multiple developmental disabilities using the "Portage" technique.

BENEFICIARIES:

In 2018, 7 Portage pilot teams were formed in 5 orphanages and centers:

- Rybnov Orphanage, Ryazan Region,
- Arzamas Orphanage, Nizhny Novgorod Region,
- Center for the Promotion of Family Education "Skolkovo", Moscow,
- Center for the Promotion of Family Education "Faith. Hope. Love. ", Moscow
- Center for Clinical Education in Pskov
- Pervomaiskiy Orphanage

RESULTS:

An installation session was held, 36 specialists gained experience in teamwork and experience with children using the "Portage" method. The pilot projects were attended by 26 children with severe and multiple developmental disorders. During the year, "mother-nannies" were engaged with them according to the Portage methodology and conducted 1430 lessons.

Project: "Innovations for children with severe developmental disabilities and orphans" is a group of projects aimed at improving the quality of life of children with MSD and improving the quality of social services. In the group of innovative projects, we include the following:

- Project "Verticalization"
- Project "Canis Therapy"
- Project "Pilot teams Portage"
- Project "Practice Portage"

Our innovative projects are aimed at:

- development and assistance in the integration of "orphaned" into society through the creation of a community of specialists practicing innovative working methods;
- training specialists and the provision of individually oriented psychological, pedagogical and social assistance to children in families and orphanages.


The project is carried out in partnership with the Moscow Family Education Promotion Centers and orphanages in the regions.




Key results from 2016 to 2018:

- Children-patients of the Children's Orthopedic Department of the FGBU FB ITU Ministry of Labor of Russia.




Quality of Life Project

RESULTS 2018

2 chambers and an electrical miostimulation room in the Children's Orthopedic Department of the hospital were repaired and refurbished, massage tables, treadmills, a split system, and Balkan frames were purchased.

About 3,000 children with musculoskeletal disorders from all over Russia are treated here annually.













TAKE A STEP PROGRAM



PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

- Assistance in changing and improving the quality of life of children with congenital and acquired disabilities of physical development by financing medical intervention, operations, rehabilitation treatment, and providing technical means of rehabilitation.

Families seeking help from the Fund are often in critical situations because of the inability to pay for the costly treatment and rehabilitation of their children. As a result, many children, especially in the regions, living away from district centers, are left without treatment and fall into social isolation.

WE PAY FOR:

- surgical intervention with a set of necessary consultative and diagnostic pre- and postoperative services;
- rehabilitation courses;
- technical means of rehabilitation
- stay of the child in the clinic/rehabilitation center;
- stay of an accompanying person in the hospital (if necessary)

TAKE A STEP PROGRAM


In 2018, we assisted 12 children from different cities and regions of Russia for a total of 4,841,835.25 rubles.

RESULTS:

Thanks to the help provided, the health of children with severe disabilities of psychophysical development is constantly improving. All children, whom we helped in 2018, had comprehensive health improvements:

- Fine motor skills: some children can now open their hands, which is a prerequisite for manipulative actions with objects, including the ability to drink, eat, draw, dress, etc.
- Motor activity: in many children the muscle strength was increased, spacticity decreased some children can now stand, and sit, one of the children began to stand and walk with support, and some - even independently!
- The development of speech: there are children who pronounce only certain sounds, syllables or individual words, someone tries to pronounce the sentences completely and are happy that other people can understand them better.
- Mental development: some children study in schools - the level of their intellectual development has improved noticeably.

The costs of assisting children with severe mental and physical developmental disorders, cerebral palsy in 2018 were distributed as follows:

GOAL OF THE PROJECT - To create an information resource and provide information support to needy families, parents with children, and inform the donors about children and families who need their help.


WHAT WE ARE DOING:

ISM is the International School of Moscow, the teachers and students of which for the fifth time are holding this grand event and really help children.

About 1,300,000 rubles of donations were collected for two funds and 682,500 rubles were donated to the Diema's Dream Fund

All evening the school students sang, played their works and works of famous authors, showed excerpts of the musical, plucked a standing ovation and received unconditional support and enthusiasm from parents and teachers! It was just an unforgettable sight! Who would have thought that so many talented children are studying at the same school!?

Drive RENAULT for a whole year

In 2018, Renault Russia and I made 4 trips to the Elatom orphanage, which is 340 km away. from Moscow - an orthopedic professor was transported as part of the Verticalization project. We went to the Kimovsky Orphanage twice to provide graduates with basic necessities.

The car was necessary in organizing our participation in the DREAMS Show and the Music Marathon. We also made 117 fundraising trips.

Thanks to this, 20 children received assistance in the amount of 4,273,380 rubles. : 16 paid courses of treatment or rehabilitation, as well as 4 paid technical means of rehabilitation!

In 2018, assistance projects in 10 orphanages, centers for promoting family education and in the hospital also worked, more than 3,000 children from all over Russia received assistance.


Also used the vehicle for seminars, installation sessions and round tables on the projects "Portage".

FINANCIAL REPORT 2018

- The fund strictly monitors the purpose of the proceeds and provides a detailed report upon written request from donors or on the conditions specified in donation agreements. The public financial statements are posted on the Fund's website www.ddfrussia.ru in the Reports section.
- Reports on the collection and spending of funds for the Step Towards Charity program are published in a separate brochure once every six months and are posted at BP gas stations.
- All donations are first credited to the fund, and only then can be used. Funds received with an appointment "for statutory activities" are allocated to the most urgent needs, guided by the decisions of the Board.
