OUR MISSION

- To provide effective, professional and comprehensive support to children with serious and varied developmental disabilities and to their families
- To help disabled children adapt to society and change the public attitude towards disabled people



Project "Canis-therapy"

THE GOAL – of the project is to rehabilitate and improve the quality of life of orphans with severe disabilities of psychophysical development through conducting Canis therapy.

THE BENEFICIARIES

- Children of the SSCV "Vera.Nadezhda.Lyubov", Moscow.
- Children of the SSCV "Doveriye" Moscow.

RESULTS: Over the course of the year, more than 130 children with severe and multiple developmental disabilities took part in canis-therapy sessions. 54 visits by canis therapists conducted 162 hours of sessions.

As a result practically everyone has positive changes:

- Children began to feel their body better
- Decreases of muscle spasm
- Improves coordination of movements
- Improves the emotional state
- Speech and other communication skills improve
- Phobias were gone
- Cognitive activity develops
- These children have become more independent

Verticalization Project

GOAL OF THE PROJECT is the rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of children and orphans of the “Mercy” group (with severe disorders of psychophysical development) through the organization of regular work of orthopedists and physiotherapy exercises to ensure that the child reaches the vertical position of the body.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- We pay for work and travel of orthopedists from the federal orthopedic center in Moscow to children over 350 km from Moscow
- We pay for the daily work of specialists of adaptive physical education, massage, dressing of orthoses
- We pay the costs of hospitalization of orphans from the Ryazan region to a hospital in Moscow: we provide nannies, hygiene products and food

PROJECT PARTICIPANTS:

- 18 Children from Elatma`s orphanage

THANKS TO THE PROJECT many children:

- learned to stand by themselves, some walk completely independently, someone with support by hands or with walkers,
- to varying degrees, in all children the muscles of the neck, back, legs strengthened, everyone continues to grow and gain weight,
- the children are increasingly showing interest in the world around them, have become attentive, active, sociable and smiling.





Charity Help Project

PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT– improving the quality of life of children in orphanages and boarding schools by organizing social, developmental, cultural, educational events and increasing material support, satisfying spiritual and material needs.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- We carry out developmental activities
- Organize rehabilitation and medical care
- We purchase wheelchairs, orthoses, other technical rehabilitation means
- Promote social adaptation of children
- Organize holidays, cultural, cognitive, volunteer activities
- Improve the living conditions of children (furniture, hygiene products, linens, clothes, shoes, etc.)
- We acquire special development equipment, materials for classes, development and creativity, methodological materials, equipment for playgrounds, sensory rooms, etc.
- We support the exchange of best practices in the field of rehabilitation and psychological care for children with special needs

RESULTS 2019 - Thanks to your donation, the help was provided to patients of the Federal State Budgetary Institution "Federal Bureau of Medical and Social Expertise" of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Russian Federation (FSBI FSE ITU Ministry of Labor of Russia):



I) Acquired 8 medical pharmaceutical refrigerator-cabinets for storing medicines in 5 departments of the clinic, a pharmacy and a clinic.

II) Purchased 12 household refrigerators for storing patient products in 7 departments of the clinic FBMSE.

III) 8 split systems for 8 departments of the federal clinic were purchased and installed.

RESULTS 2019

The FBMSE Clinic provides services to more than 11,000 patients annually. People from all over Russia come here for high-tech medical care.

Typically, most patients have a disability, low income and quality of life. In general, patients receive medical services according to the compulsory medical insurance policy. At the same time, there was an urgent need for financial assistance in acquiring equipment to provide quality medical care. How to provide quality services when refrigerators for storing medicines are absent or unsuitable for use in treatment rooms? For storage of drugs in each department there should be a place where the temperature requirements are constantly observed. To do this, split systems were installed in the offices of senior nurses.

Patients' quality of life also improves significantly when patients can receive additional nutrition. And for this, we needed refrigerators for storing personal products. Thus, without your help it would be impossible to improve the quality of the services provided, to ensure a comfortable stay.

NEW YEAR'S HOLIDAYS: together with employees of Boeing, Renault and others, we collected individual and group Christmas gifts (educational toys, new individual clothes, shoes) for children from orphanages:

- Kimovsky Orphanage, Tula Region
- Elatom orphanage, Ryazan region
- Bobrovsky orphanage, Pskov region



PORTAGE PROJECT



OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT - Rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of orphans with severe disabilities of the psycho-physical development of the "Mercy" groups by conducting educational activities with children using the "Portage" method.

BENEFIT RECIPIENTS :

- GKU "Elatom orphanage - a boarding school for mentally retarded children" (Ryazan region).
- GBU "Arzamas orphanage for mentally retarded children" (Nizhny Novgorod region).
- GKU "Pervomaysky orphanage - a boarding school for mentally retarded children" (Kostroma region).
- The center of medical pedagogy and differential education in the Pskov region.
- Center for the Promotion of Family Education "Doveriye" (Moscow).
- Center for the Promotion of Family Education "Skolkovsky" (Moscow).

As a result of this many years of painstaking work, children who were considered hopeless have acquired new skills that were previously inaccessible to them:

- wash and dress,
- chew and swallow food, feed yourself,
- sit and stand,
- distinguish colors, count, collect constructors, cut,
- and many other skills in the field of movement, cognition, self-service, socialization.

RESULTS: with 142 children with severe and multiple developmental disorders during the year, "mothers-nannies" were engaged in the Portage method and conducted 11 069 sessions per year.

Consultation of specialists of trust institutions with foreign colleagues on the application of the method "Portage and postural control.

PORTAGE

From 2013 to 2019:

- 45,623 individual sessions for children with severe intellectual and physical disabilities - verticalization and development of life skills
- over 169 children
- 12 teams of Portage specialists
- 8 orphanages / CSSV in Moscow, Pskov, Arzamas, Ryazan and Kostroma regions



PORTAGE

How does the "Portage" method work?

As a result of classes, children began to develop and acquire skills in the field of movement, cognition, communication and self-service. They learned to do many things that were not available to them before:

Wash, wash hands and dress, chew and swallow food, drink and eat on your own,

sit, stand, walk with support or alone, distinguish colors,

count, collect simple sets, cut with scissors, play and much more.



OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT – Rehabilitation and improvement of the quality of life of orphans with severe diseases. Dissemination of the best practices of working with children of the "Mercy" group and children with severe and multiple developmental disabilities using the "Portage" technique.

BENEFICIARIES:

In 2019, work was underway on the formation of 7 pilot teams Portage in child care facilities:

Center for medical pedagogy and differential education in the Pskov region,

TSSVS "Southern Butovo" (Moscow),

ANO TsSP "Good Deed" (Ryazan),

ANO "Resource Center for the Prevention of Social Orphanhood" (Ryazan).

Center for the Promotion of Family Education "Vera. Hope. Love (Moscow).

OGBU "Rybnovskaya boarding school for orphans and children left without parental care" (Ryazan region).

GBU "Arzamas orphanage for mentally retarded children" (Nizhny Novgorod region).

RESULTS:

Installation sessions were held, 48 specialists gained experience in teamwork and experience with children using the "Portage" method. The pilot projects were attended by 81 children with severe and multiple developmental disorders. Throughout the year, "mother-nannies" were engaged with them according to the Portage methodology and conducted 3 383 lessons.

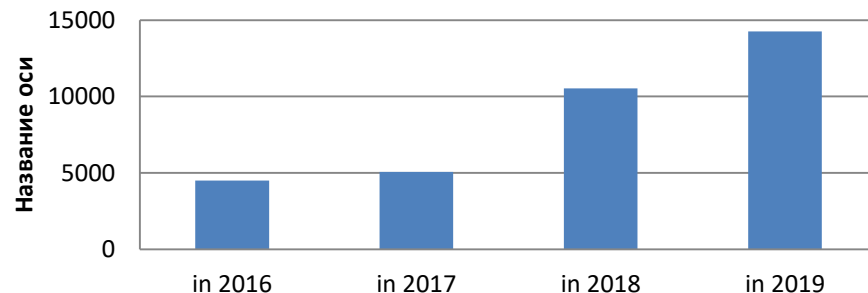


Innovations for children with severe developmental disabilities and orphans

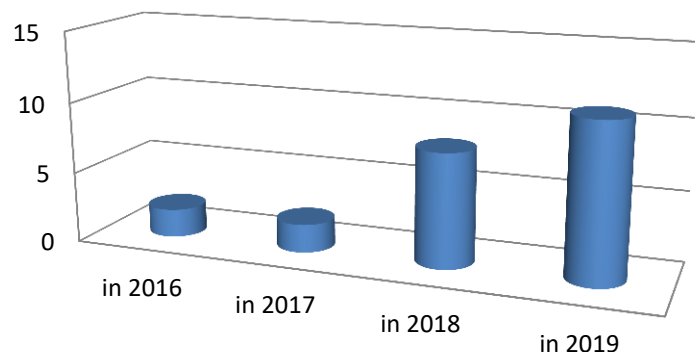
Key results from 2016 to 2019:

- 97 specialists participated in Diema's Dream Projects
- 221 children participated in Portage projects
- 45,623 individual developmental classes. Portage was supported by the foundation.

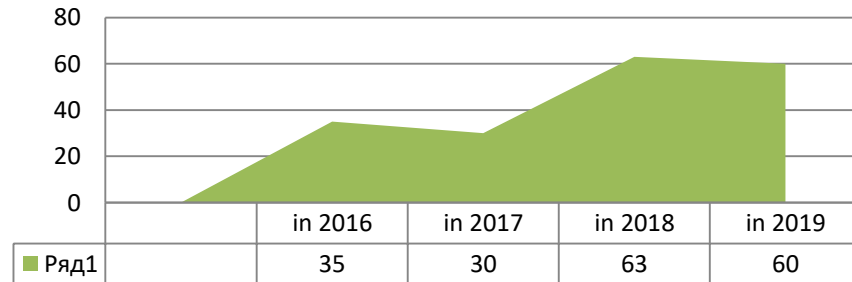
Portage Sessions

Innovations for children with severe developmental disabilities and orphans

Key results from 2016 to 2019:

- 6 Workshops Portage Seminars held (3-day training)
- 188 specialists from 38 orphanages, psychological and pedagogical centers, centers for promoting family education, centers for assisting families and children, special kindergartens, students of specialized universities, volunteers and representatives of charitable organizations were trained,
- 188 copies Guides on the “Portage” methodology are published and handed over to specialists.

TAKE A STEP PROGRAM

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

- Assistance in changing and improving the quality of life of children with congenital and acquired disabilities of physical development by financing medical intervention, operations, rehabilitation treatment, and providing technical means of rehabilitation.

Families seeking help from the Fund are often in critical situations because of the inability to pay for the costly treatment and rehabilitation of their children. As a result, many children, especially in the regions, living away from district centers, are left without treatment and fall into social isolation.

WE PAY FOR:

- surgical intervention with a set of necessary consultative and diagnostic pre- and postoperative services;
- rehabilitation courses;
- technical means of rehabilitation
- stay of the child in the clinic/rehabilitation center;
- stay of an accompanying person in the hospital (if necessary)



TAKE A STEP PROGRAM

With your help, in 2019 we helped 19 children by paying for medical measures and rehabilitation funds in the amount of 3,167,657.67 rubles.

RESULTS:

Thanks to the help provided, the health of children with severe disabilities of psychophysical development is constantly improving. All children, whom we helped in 2019, had comprehensive health improvements:

- Fine motor skills: some children can now open their hands, which is a prerequisite for manipulative actions with objects, including the ability to drink, eat, draw, dress, etc.
- Motor activity: in many children the muscle strength was increased, spasticity decreased - some children can now stand, and sit, one of the children began to stand and walk with support, and some - even independently!
- The development of speech: there are children who pronounce only certain sounds, syllables or individual words, someone tries to pronounce the sentences completely and are happy that other people can understand them better.
- Mental development: some children study in schools - the level of their intellectual development has improved noticeably.

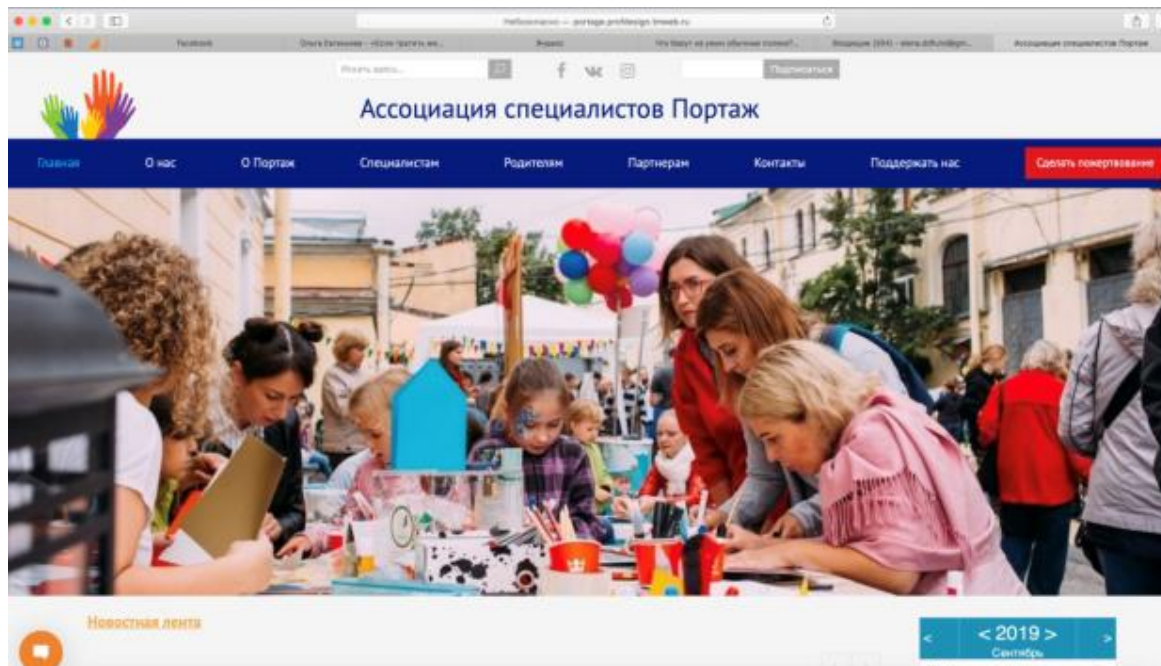


"HELP TO OUR CHILDREN!" PROJECT

GOAL OF THE PROJECT - To create an information resource and provide information support to needy families, parents with children, and inform the donors about children and families who need their help.

RESULTS 2019

In 2019, we organized a number of major fundraising events and created a prototype site for the Portage Association of Specialists in Russia.

Together with RENAULT

In 2019, Renault Russia and I made 11 trips to orphanages in Moscow, the Tula, Ryazan and Kostroma regions (6 wards) with the delivery of material assistance. Without the help of Renault Russia, we would not have a car of the right capacity, where you can put all the bags and boxes.

4 trips of orthopedic doctor Pozharischensky K.E. (Honored Doctor of Russia, Professor, Head of the Children's Orthopedic Department of the Federal Bureau of Medical and Social Expertise of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Russian Federation (Moscow) to 1 ward institution were organized.

Thanks to this, more than 60 children from the outback received highly qualified assistance in the rehabilitation of disorders of the musculoskeletal system.

Organized and conducted a training seminar "Basic principles of the "Portage" methodology in individual work with children with disabilities" in Moscow;

Organized the work of 13 teams on the technique of "Portage" in children's institutions in Russia.

In the fall of 2019, they held a Round Table on the results of pilot projects and Projects Practice Portage Projects in Moscow, in the village of Elatma, Ryazan Region, in the city of Pskov, in the city of Kostroma.

They inspired and started cooperation with 3 more new orphanages and orphanages. Now, help for children with the most severe developmental disabilities will reach there.



Charity Auction DREAMS'2019

GUM Trading House has always provided invaluable assistance in organizing the event, and in 2019, Hyatt Regency came to our aid! It was incredibly important.

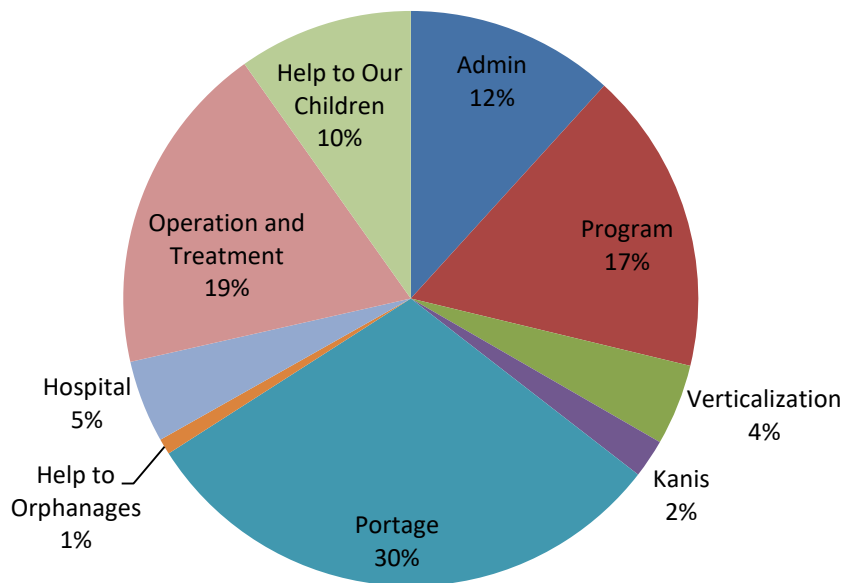

The balance of funds at the beginning of the year amounted to 11117478.32 rubles.

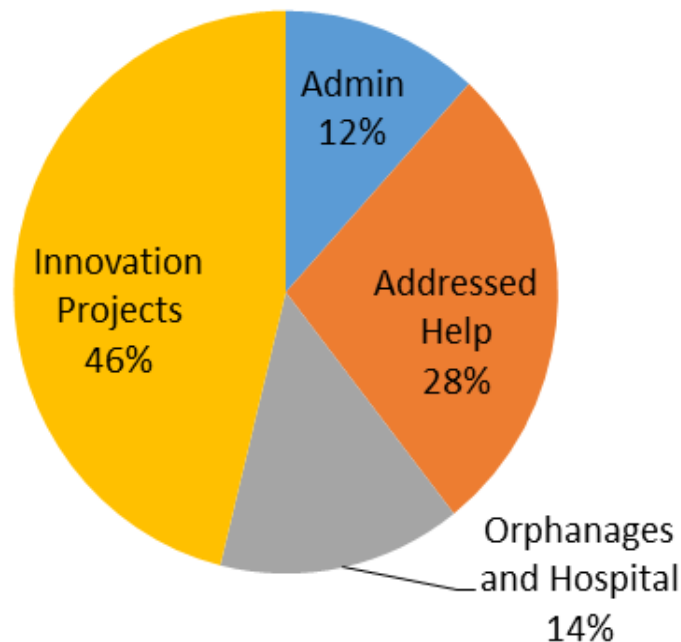
In 2019, 24995016.32 rubles of donations were received to the fund's account.

The balance at the end of the year is 14440086 rubles, of which 4181725 rubles are reserved for projects, and 10258360 is the balance for statutory activities.

Reports on the collection and spending of funds for the Step Towards Charity program are published in a separate brochure once every six months and are posted at BP gas stations.

All donations are first credited to the fund, and only then can be used. Funds received with an appointment "for statutory activities" are allocated to the most urgent needs, guided by the decisions of the Board.
